**Annotation to the modules:**EuPoD II:

In module EuPoD II you have to pass a lecture and a tutorial in the second term. For the lecture (EuPoD II 3) you can choose either „History of Eastern-Central Europe“ or another historical scientific lecture; In module EuPoD II 4 you can choose either „History of Eastern-Central Europe“ or another historical scientific tutorial.

EuPoD III:

In module EuPoD III you choose either linguistics or literary and cultural sciences. During two terms you will pass four courses from the chosen subject.

EuPoD V b:

Polish students with German language skills at level C1/C2 according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages have the opportunity to take courses from all departments participating in the programme as an alternative to module EuPoD V b.

EuPoD VI:

You can study either the a-module (EuPoD VI a 1, EuPoD VI a 2 and EuPoD VI a 3) or b-module (EuPoD VI b 1, EuPoD VI b 2 and EuPoD VI b 3) or the c-module (EuPoD VI c 1, EuPoD VI c 2 and EuPoD VI c 3), so that a main focus is set on Eastern European History or Linguistics or Literary and Cultural Studies.

The Colloquium "Eastern European History" (EuPoD VI a 2) covers the history of Eastern Europe as well as Eastern-Central Europe. Within modules EuPoD VI b and EuPoD VI c the you decide either for German Philology or Polish Philology. In consequence, either three courses in Polish Philology or three courses in German Philology have to be completed.

EuPoD VII:

You study either the a-modules (EuPoD VII a 1 and EuPoD VII a 2) or the b-modules (EuPoD VII b 1 and EuPoD VII b 2), so that an immersion in Political Sciences or Law takes place.

EuPoD VIII b:

Polish students with German language skills at level C1/C2 according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages have the opportunity to take courses from all departments participating in the programme as an alternative to module EuPoD VIII b.
